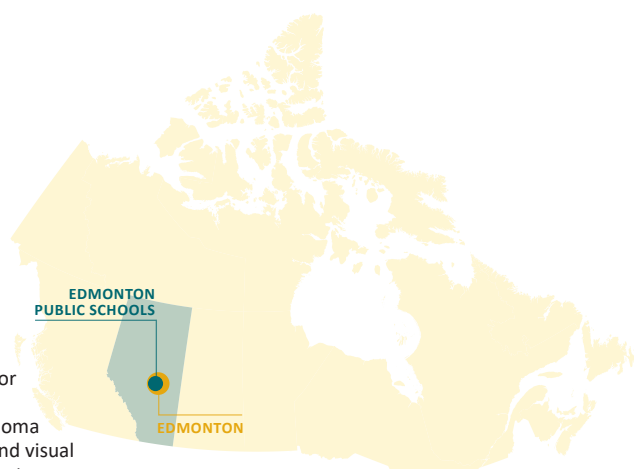

DISTRICT PROFILE

Located in the province of Alberta's largest and capital city, the Edmonton Public Schools District is recognized as one of the best in Canada. Alberta is renowned for its high quality of education, ranking No. 2 in the world in both reading and science scores, and in the top 12 for math. Students choose from 11 schools offering various unique programs such as the International Baccalaureate Diploma, interest-based alternative tracks, and AP courses.

FACILITIES

Students at Edmonton Public Schools have access to facilities such as ice rinks, swimming pools, curling arenas, golf courses, and private fitness facilities. Further facilities include computer labs, drama theaters, music labs, language labs, fabrication design studios, large gymnasiums, food labs, and art studios. All schools in the district are equipped with modern amenities and technologies such as Smartboards and Google Chromebooks.

SPORTS AND ARTS

Students can choose from freshman, junior varsity, and varsity sports programs at each school. Pre-professional athletes' competition schedules can be accommodated by Vimy Ridge Academy's flexible Elite track.

In addition to academic art options such as graphic arts and improv, students can choose from extracurricular activities like drumline, performing arts, and concert choir.

AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The district is located in the province of Alberta, which is placed at No. 2 on the world ranking of test scores in reading and science, and is No. 12 in math. The schools' superior athletic programs have made provincial history, with being the first and only to win three different championships in one season and another producing Olympic and professional athletes.
