SCHOOL PROFILE

Stephen A. Leacock Collegiate Institute is located in the Scarborough region of Toronto. It is the home of the unique APEX (Advanced Placement Courses on Academic and Social Excellence) program, which enables students to push themselves academically while also helping the community through various social justice efforts. It also offers all levels of ESL instruction.

FACILITIES

The school's facilities are quite impressive, and represent the large variety of courses that students can enroll in. These include a specialized TV/digital media production facility, a fully-equipped athletic facility with a pool, and a 650-seat auditorium with a DMX lighting console.

SPORTS AND ARTS

Students at Stephen Leacock are encouraged to participate in athletic activities. The school has a traditionally competitive basketball program, with the senior girl's team taking home the 2017-2018 Senior AA Girls Championship.

To complement the large number of performing and visual arts opportunities, the school has an aforementioned 650-seat auditorium and specialized TV/digital media production facility.
