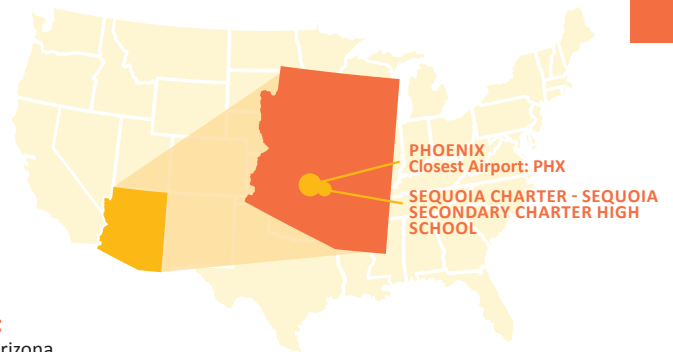




# Sequoia Charter Schools District

Sequoia Secondary Charter High School is one of the largest public charter schools in Arizona. Sequoia offers dual enrollment courses for college credit as well as an Ambassador program in which all international students are paired with a local student to help them acclimate to the school. The district also has one of the top performing arts schools in the Phoenix area. International students make up less than 5% of the district's student body.
