SCHOOL PROFILE

Founded in 1997, San Francisco Waldorf High School is one of more than 1,000 Waldorf schools worldwide. All students study physics and calculus and have the opportunity to take Advanced Placement and honors courses. San Francisco Waldorf also takes part in the "Outdoor Classroom" initiative in order to connect students with nature and all that San Francisco has to offer.

The campus has classrooms, state-of-the-art science labs, dedicated art studios, and a library media center with access to Macs and PCs.

International students are encouraged to participate in sports like sailing, which is offered year-round.

All students take four years of music and art. They conclude each year with musical and theater performances and an annual arts showcase event so students can experiment with what they have learned.

San Francisco Waldorf was the first school in San Francisco to be awarded the LEED Gold Certification for environmental design.
