FACILITIES

There are a number of great facilities on the 25-acre campus at 'Iolani School. The Sullivan Center for Innovation and Leadership is a 40,000 square foot building that is home to research science, design, and applied technologies. Outside of the academic buildings, students can use a number of athletic facilities, including fields, a pool, and a six lane outdoor track.

SPORTS AND ARTS

The Raiders have won more than 75 state championships with 'Iolani being the only school to win five consecutive boy's basketball championships (2002-2006). The 'Iolani arts program consists of 32 performing arts groups and over 15 course offerings including AP classes. Student performances have brought 'Iolani several awards and special invites to perform in the US and internationally.

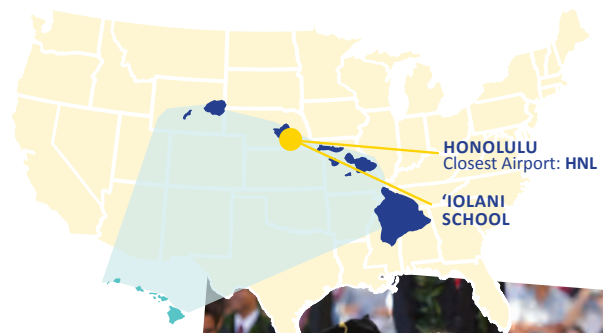
