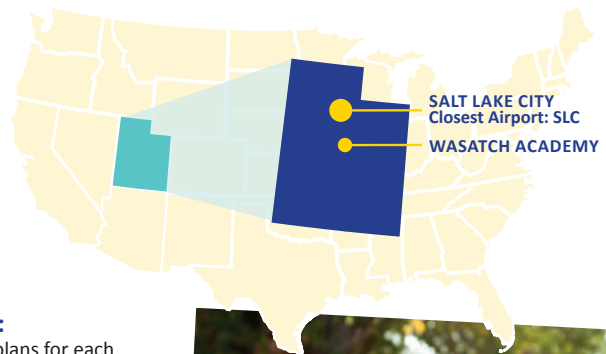




Wasatch Academy
