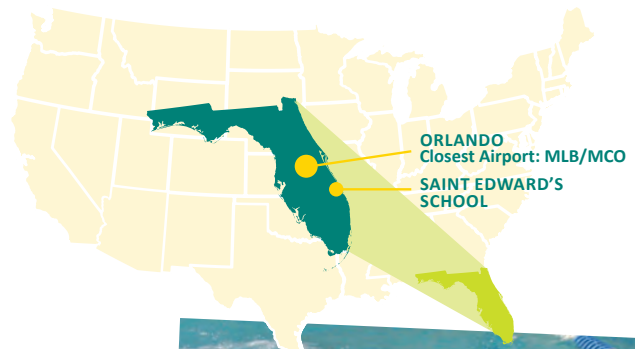




# Saint Edward's School
