### SCHOOL PROFILE

Founded in 1963, Lake Ridge Academy is the only independent college preparatory school on Cleveland's west side. It offers students a number of unique programs like entrepreneurial studies, anatomy and physiology, and developmental biology and embryology. The school also offers independent studies in subjects like multi-variable calculus.

### FACILITIES

The 93 acre campus includes a garden, a brand new science and engineering building, a gymnasium, a weight/workout facility, and outside sports facilities.
