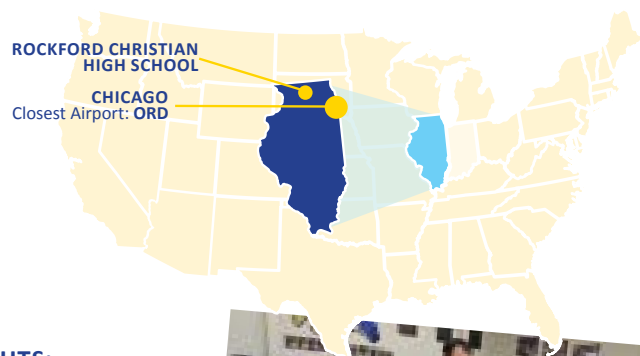

Rockford Christian High School is a private, non-denominational Christian day school that welcomes a select group of international students to board on campus every year. The school offers a wide variety of classes including 22 Advanced Placement courses, CAD Programming, graphic design, robotics, and a comprehensive STEAM curriculum.

### FACILITIES

The campus covers 35-acres and features facilities such as advanced technology classrooms, computer labs, science labs, and a stadium. There is also an advanced art laboratory for graphic design and LEED-certified Science and Technology Center.

Students are always encouraged to participate in sports teams and clubs like swimming, soccer, and even bass fishing.

Rockford Christian High School's fine arts faculty is comprised of professional artists and musicians that help students put on programs and concerts throughout the year.
