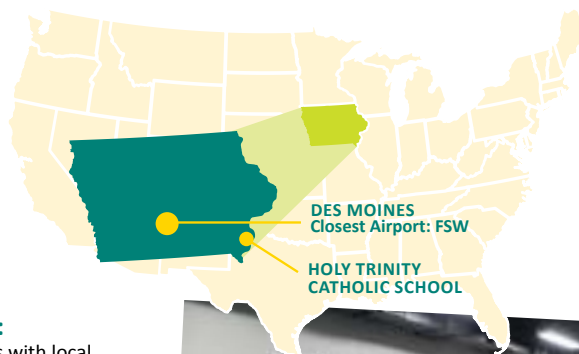

AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

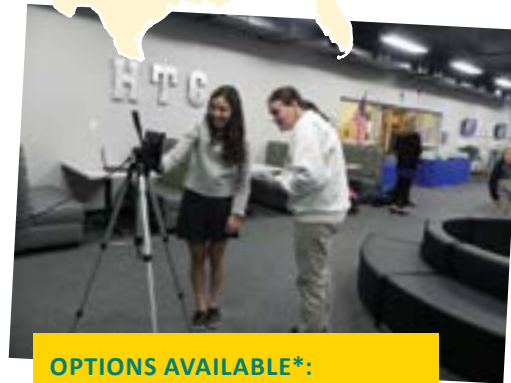
