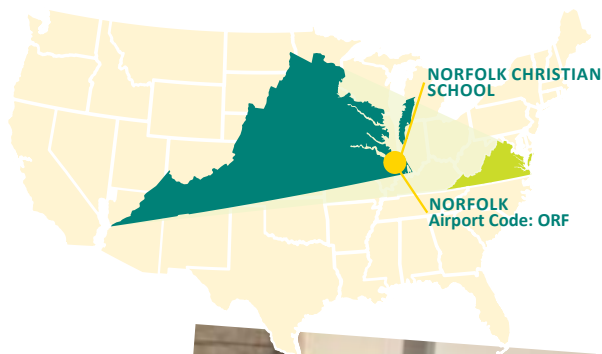




Norfolk Christian School
