AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

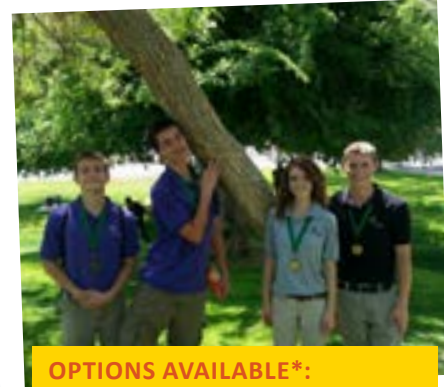
Five teachers received Teacher of the Year awards in 2018 from the Casa Grande Community. Students also received the Youth Entrepreneurs Mountain West Student Award.
