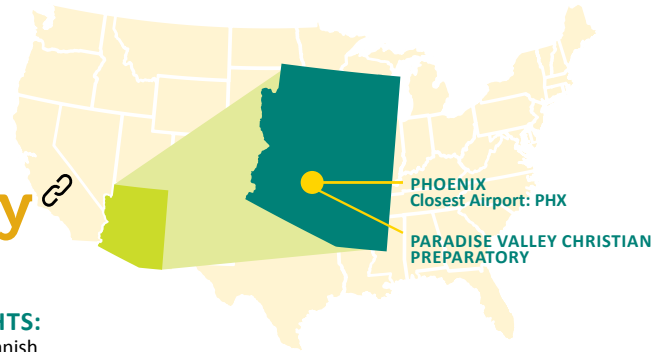




Paradise Valley Christian Preparatory
