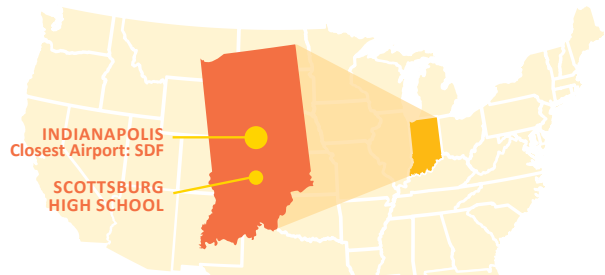

SCHOOL PROFILE

Located just over an hour from the capital of Indiana, Scottsburg High School offers two academic tracks along with award-winning arts and athletics programs. Students can choose to follow the technology/STEM academic track or participate in the High Schools That Work program to explore different career clusters such as agriculture, architecture, or human services.

Students have access to high-tech classroom equipment and amenities as well as mobile devices provided by the school and features specific to the different career clusters. Athletic facilities include a football field, softball and baseball diamonds, and a track.

Students can participate in various art options such as Scottsburg's award-winning band program as well as courses and extracurriculars such as acting class and drama club.

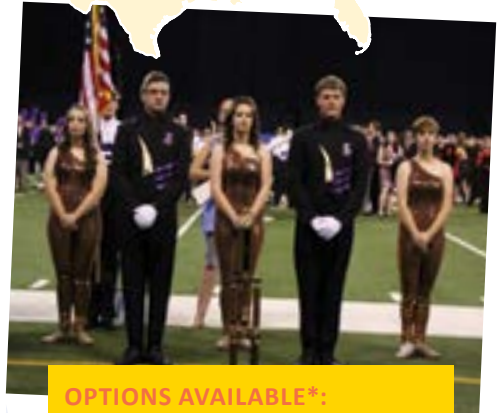
AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS
