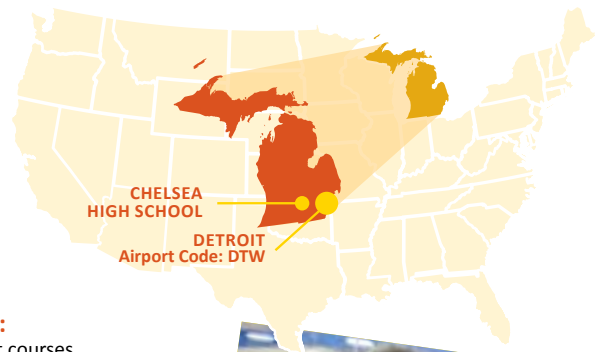

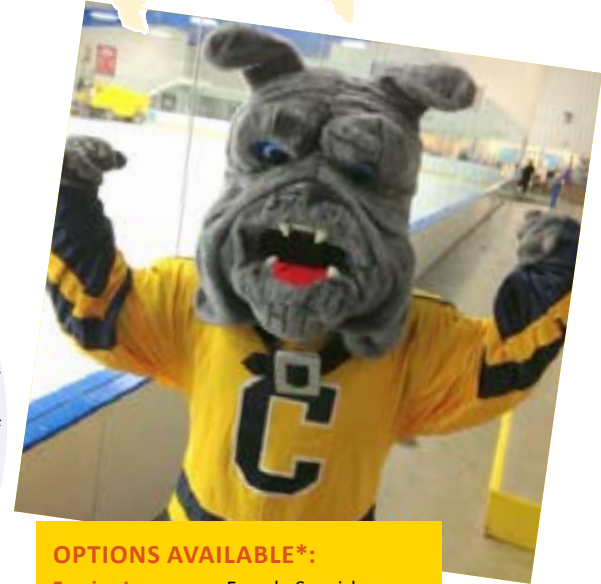
Students can explore both fine and performing arts, including areas like ceramics, drawing, musical production, and theater.
