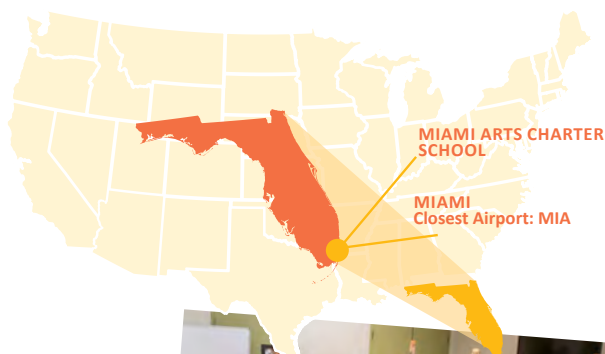

Instead of a traditional team sports program, the Physical Education program covers volleyball, football, basketball, soccer, and baseball. 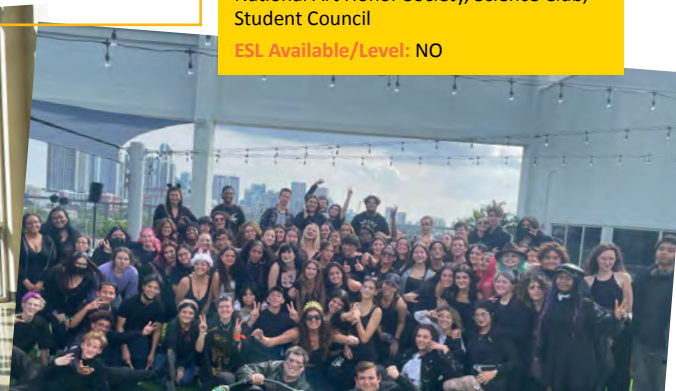
