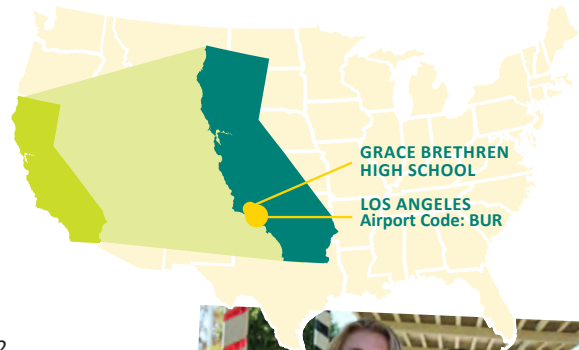




# Grace Brethren High School
