DUBLIN

Foxrock is a leafy suburb in South County Dublin situated between the sea at Dún Laoghaire and the foothills of the Dublin Mountains, approximately 12 km from Dublin city. Foxrock was developed in 1859 when the lands of the Foxrock Estate were transformed with the aim of creating an affluent garden suburb. Foxrock borders the suburbs of Carrickmines, Cornelscourt, Deansgrange and Leopardstown. The suburb offers various sports facilities, fashion boutiques, restaurants, and cafés.
